This finding aid describes the Library of the Deutsches Haus, which is an addition to the Deutsches Haus Collection, on loan to The Historic New Orleans Collection from the Deutsches Haus. Most of the books in this collection originally come from the libraries of parent organizations of the Haus, such as the Deutsche Gesellschaft and the Turn Verein, and significantly predate the 1927 incorporation of the Deutsches Haus. Numerous volumes are stamped with the insignia of the Deutsche Gesellschaft or have the words "Turn Verein" handwritten on their title pages. There are also a number of volumes well enough maintained that the original numbers assigned to them in their source libraries are still visible.

The lending libraries of 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century German social and benevolent organizations were a valuable source of entertainment, education, and practical information for members. Together with the classics of German and English literature, the libraries featured the popular fiction and poetry of the day, Bibles of various religions and denominations as well as exegesis and other religious or spiritual writings, English and French grammars and dictionaries, textbooks in mathematics and the sciences, published governmental statistics, law books, business books, books for homemakers and gardeners, and city and national directories.

Surely, over the years, the libraries of the Deutsche Gesellschaft, the Turn Verein, and, later, the Deutsches Haus experienced significant attrition. Nonetheless, the four hundred-odd volumes in this collection form a clear picture of the types of materials these libraries contained, and, in turn, of the interests and necessities of the members of the organizations. Researchers interested in this material may also be interested in the library component of the manuscripts collection EL2. 1988, Archives of the Germania Lodge 46. Although a smaller collection of books than the Library of the Deutsches Haus, the Germania Lodge collection includes a *Biblioteksverzeichniss*, or Library Catalogue, from ca. 1875 which not only names the contents of the Library, but also indicates if a book had been donated by a particular member, whether it was a gift or a loan, and what its monetary value was.

The Historic New Orleans Collection has organized this library into five sections: "German Language Literature," "English Language Literature," "Religious," "History," and "Educational/Reference." In cases where an item could fit in more than one of these categories, that which seemed most appropriate was chosen.
